

DESCRIPTION

Johnstone's Graffiti Remover is for the removal of graffiti from surfaces already protected with Johnstone's Anti Graffiti Coatings. This high performance remover is quick and easy to use, leaving no residue shadowing.

COVERAGE



Johnstones Graffiti Remover will cover approximately 5-10 square metres per litre depending on the type of graffiti. Heavier applications may be required for some graffiti.

DRYING TIME



After application, Johnstones Graffiti Remover should be allowed to dwell on the surface for approximately 30 seconds. A small area should then be tested to determine whether or not the graffiti is dissolving. This procedure should be repeated for a dwell time of 3 minutes. Once the graffiti has dissolved, it can be removed with a soft clean cloth.

If the graffiti has not dissolved after 3 minutes, it is important to wipe the Graffiti Remover residues from the surface. Where the graffiti removal has not been complete, further applications may be required. A period of 24 hours should be left between applications of Johnstones Graffiti Remover in order to allow the Anti Graffiti Coating to recover and to prevent any permanent damage.

TRANSPORTATION & STORAGE

To avoid the risk of spillage always store and transport in a secure upright position. **STORE AWAY FROM HEAT AND FLAME.**

THINNER

Do not thin.

PREPARATION

Treat the surface by removing any dirt. Allow to dry or wipe dry before applying Graffiti Remover.

APPLICATION



Easy to apply by brush.

CLEANING



Replace lid firmly. Some local authorities have special facilities for the disposal of waste coatings. Do not empty product into drains or watercourses.
